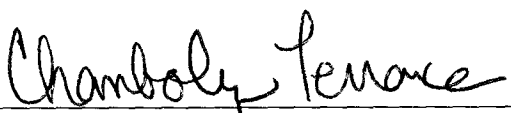

In the event relator seeks to file a new application with this court, it must contain all pertinent documentation, including the missing items noted herein, and must comply with Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rule 2-12.2. Any new application must be filed on or before September 14, 2026, and must contain a copy of this ruling.

The writ is granted for the sole purpose of ordering that relator's deadline to pay the estimated appeal costs is extended to September 24, 2026.
