STAY DENIED; WRIT NOT CONSIDERED. This was an action objecting to the candidacy of defendant, Jeffery Leon Jackson. As such, review of a judgment rendered herein is governed by the strict provisions of La. R.S. 18:1409. See **Cornelius v. Greggs**, 2021-0883 (La. App. 1st Cir. 8/2/21), 329 So.3d 314, 316 ("A party seeking relief under the Election Code must bring herself within the strict provisions of the law governing election suits. . . The legislature in drafting and enacting the Election Code sought to expedite contests involving candidacy. The short time delays are in the interest of the electorate, not the private litigants.") (Citation omitted). Relator failed to timely perfect an appeal pursuant to La. R.S. 18:1409.
