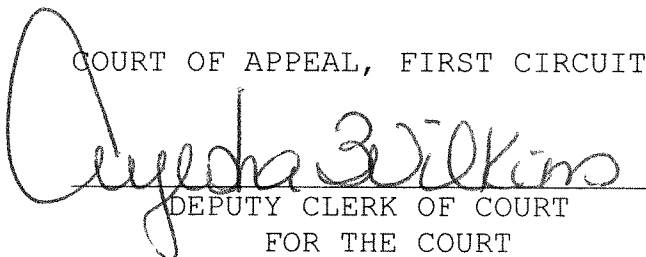
In Re: Latonya Harris, applying for supervisory writs, 32nd Judicial District Court, Parish of Terrebonne, No. 871360.
