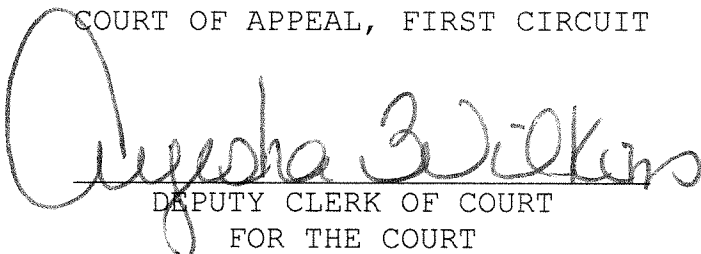

WRIT GRANTED WITH ORDER. The trial court's January 13, 2026 judgment which denied defendant's motion for summary judgment is vacated. Defendant, in its reply in support of its motion for summary judgment, raised evidentiary objections to evidence submitted by plaintiff. However, the trial court failed to rule on the evidentiary objections. La. Code Civ. P. art. 966(D)(2) provides the court "shall specifically state on the record or in writing whether the court sustains or overrules the objections raised." Accordingly, this matter is remanded to the trial court for compliance with La. Code Civ. P. art. 966(D)(2) and a ruling on the motion for summary judgment filed by defendant after determination of any evidentiary issues, pursuant to La. Civ. Code P. art. 966(C)(4).
