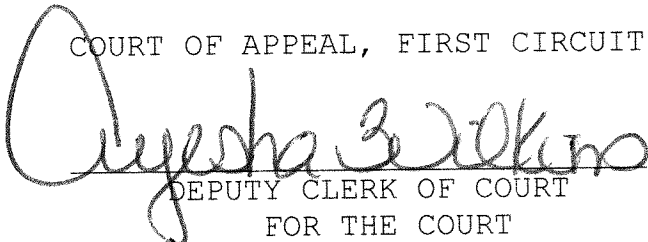
In Re: Dakota Theriot, applying for supervisory writs, 21st Judicial District Court, Parish of Livingston, No. 38517.
